

## Terms and conditions

Thank you for your interest in Benslow Music Trust's (BMT) spring raffle.

This raffle (a small society lottery) is licensed by North Herts Council. Responsible person: Peter Collyer, Benslow Music Trust, Little Benslow Hills, Ibberson Way, Hitchin SG4 9RB

These terms and conditions refer to online entries to our raffle. Entries can be purchased through our online payment provider, Enthuse.

1. The cost of each ticket entry is £2. Entrants can buy multiple tickets for £2 each. Payments to enter must be made in advance of the draw date (Monday 3 July at noon) after which entries will no longer be able to be purchased, and any sum received shall be treated as a donation.
2. Entries can only be made online. No other methods are available.
3. No more than 10,000 tickets shall be available to purchase.
4. The spring raffle is only open to entrants aged over 16. BMT reserves the right to carry out age verification checks.
5. If a ticket is sold unknowingly to, or on behalf of, or for a person under the age of 16, he/she will be exempt from the raffle and will forfeit his/her prize and the stake will be returned.
6. The spring raffle is open to all UK residents aged 16 years and over, except employees and contractors of BMT who are directly involved with the raffle.
7. Unfortunately we are unable to accept entries from the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, BFPOs and Northern Ireland.
8. The winners will be drawn using a random number generator and will be notified by Monday 17 July if they have won a prize.
9. Prizes will be allocated in order of the ticket numbers being drawn.
10. Prizes must be claimed within the time frame specified for them on Benslow Music Trust's website.
11. All proceeds, after expenses, will be used for the charitable purposes of Benslow Music Trust, registered charity number 313663.
12. Winners will be asked to be featured on the website and selected Benslow Music Trust communications including *The Buzz*. Winners will only be identified by their first name, surname initial and general location e.g. 'Sacha G, Birmingham'. Winners can choose not to be mentioned if they prefer.
